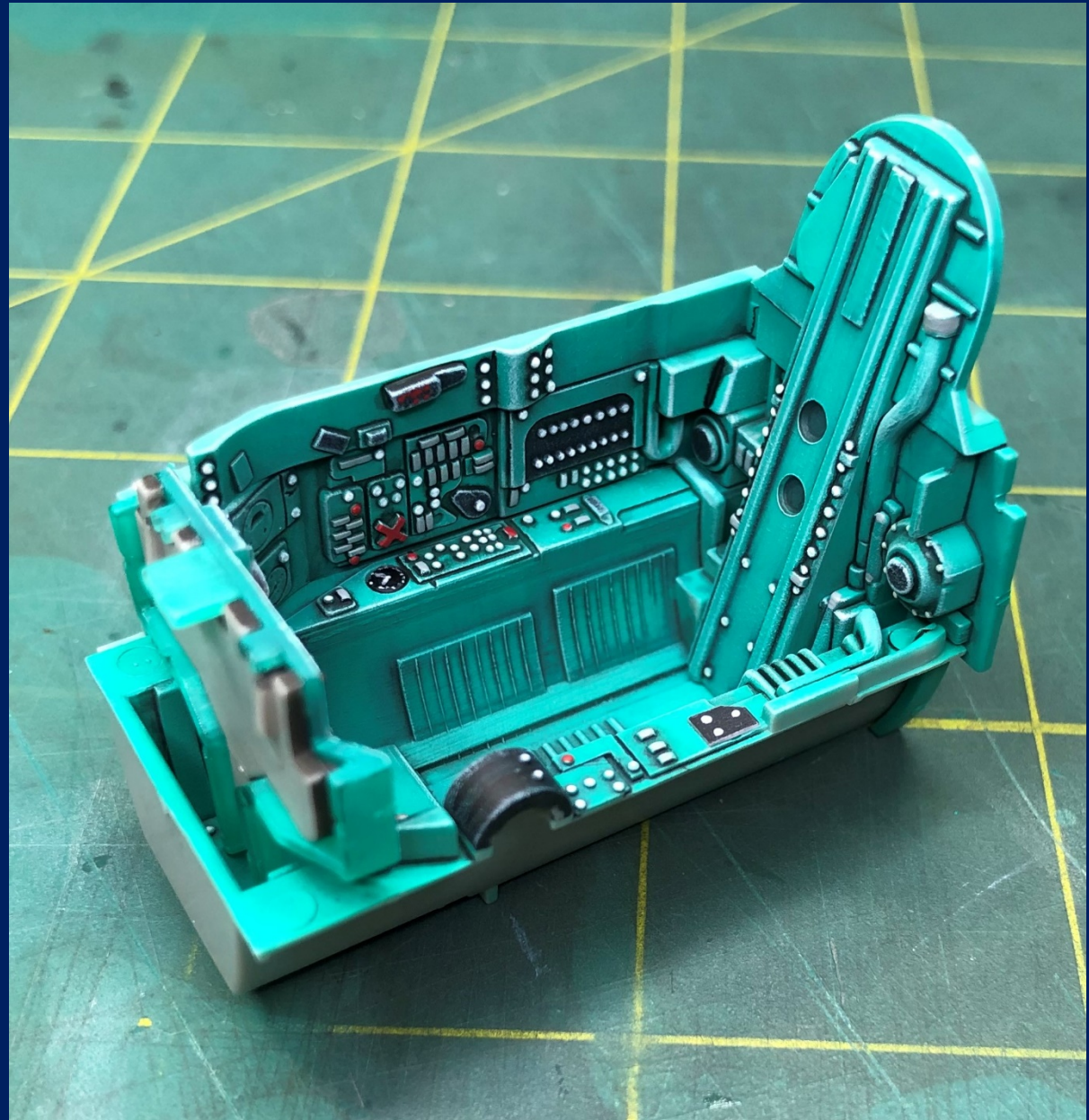

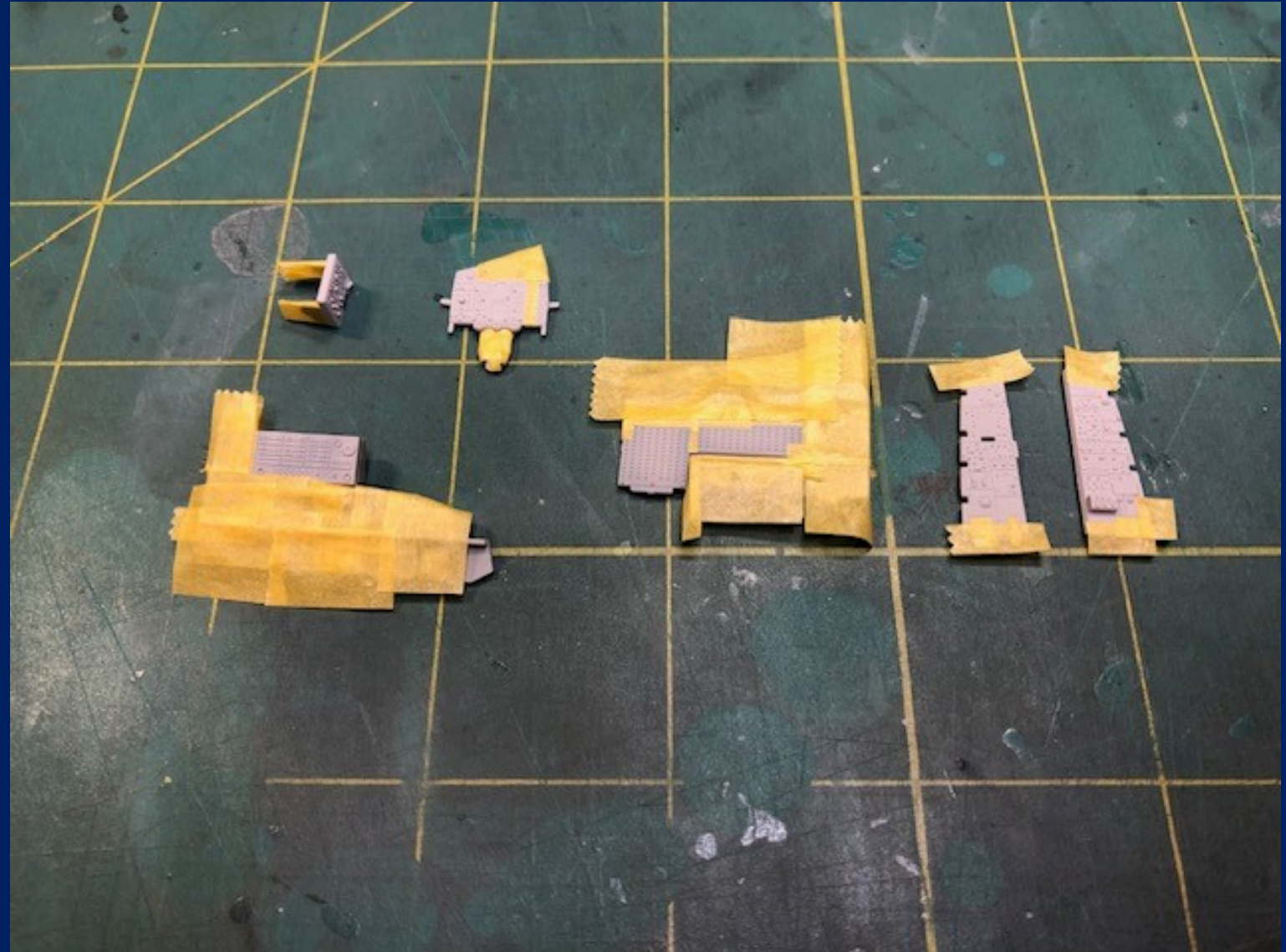

Trumpeter 1/32 Mig-21, OOB Cockpit

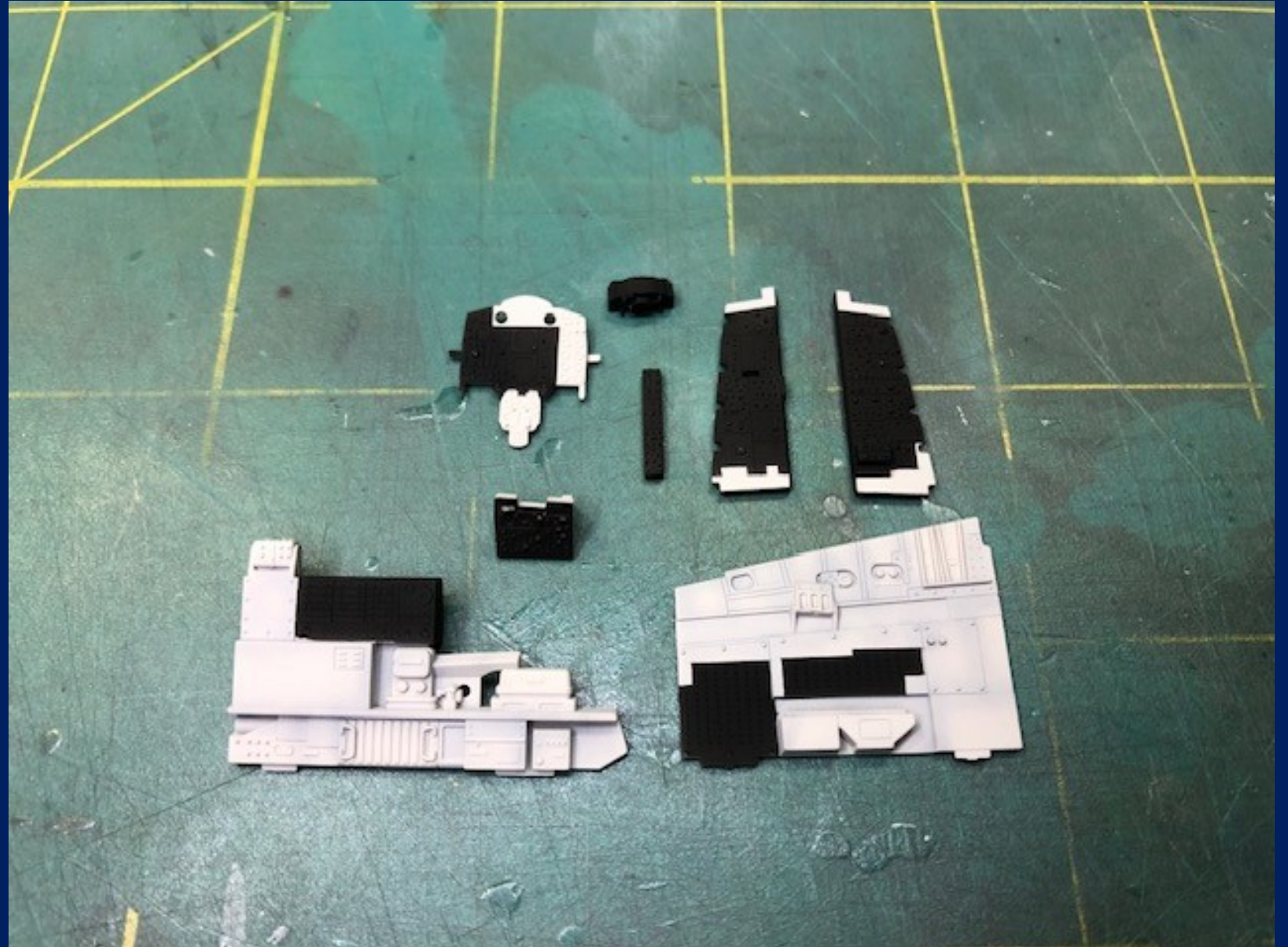
Step 1 (F-4B): Tape the Instruments and Consoles

- Once the base color is sprayed, decide which areas need tape
- Use Tamiya Tape
- Use a sharp Xacto Knife to cut
- Take your time
- Don't have to be exact
- Crisp and Clean Lines is the goal



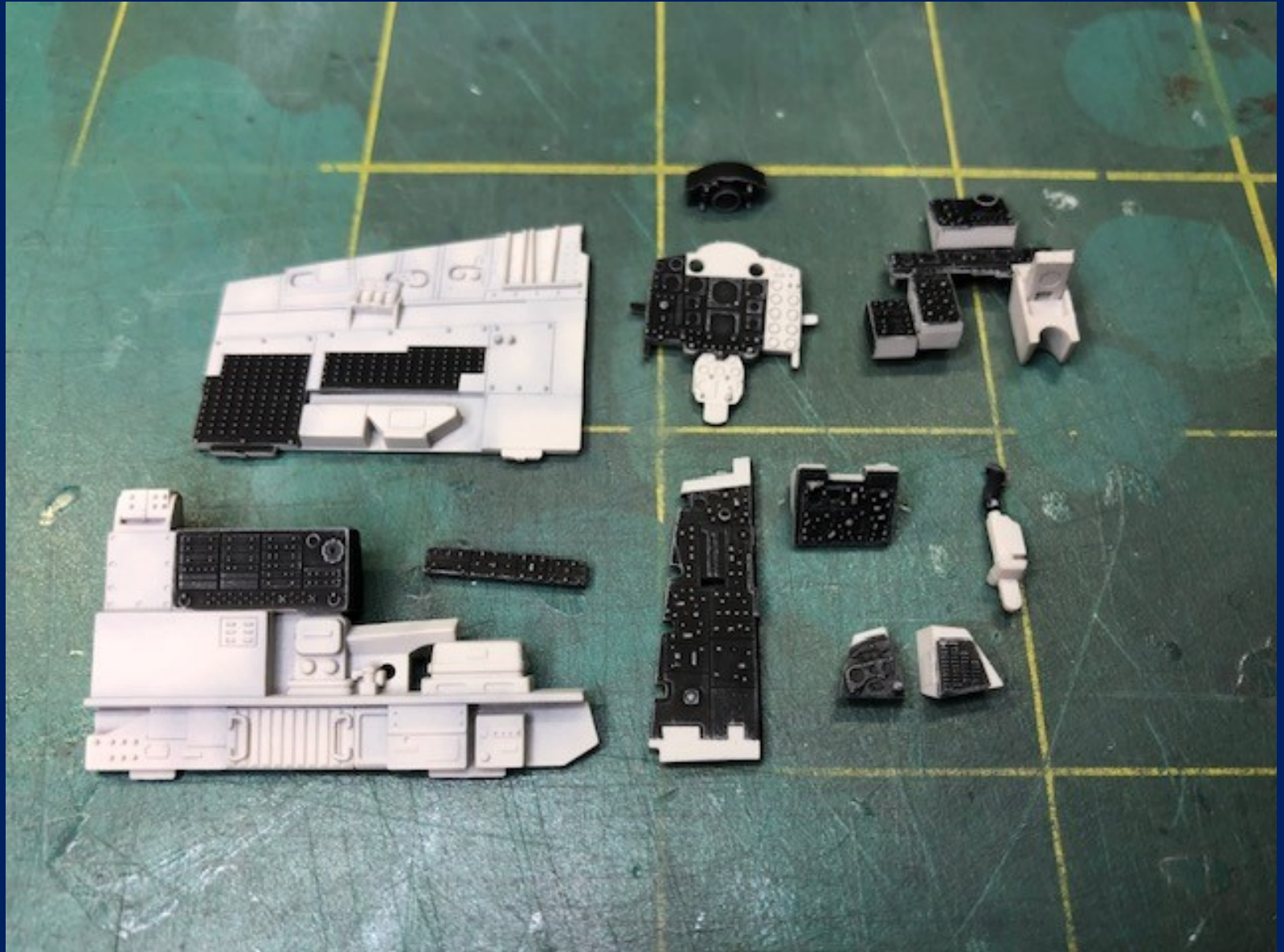
Step 2 (F-4B): Spray the Instruments and Consoles

- Choose the color for the consoles and Instruments



Step 3 (F-4B): Drybrush Neutral Gray

- Use an older flat and soft brush
- Very little paint on the brush
- Quick back and forth motion, gradually building up the paint
- The gray provides a foundational layer for the switches and details

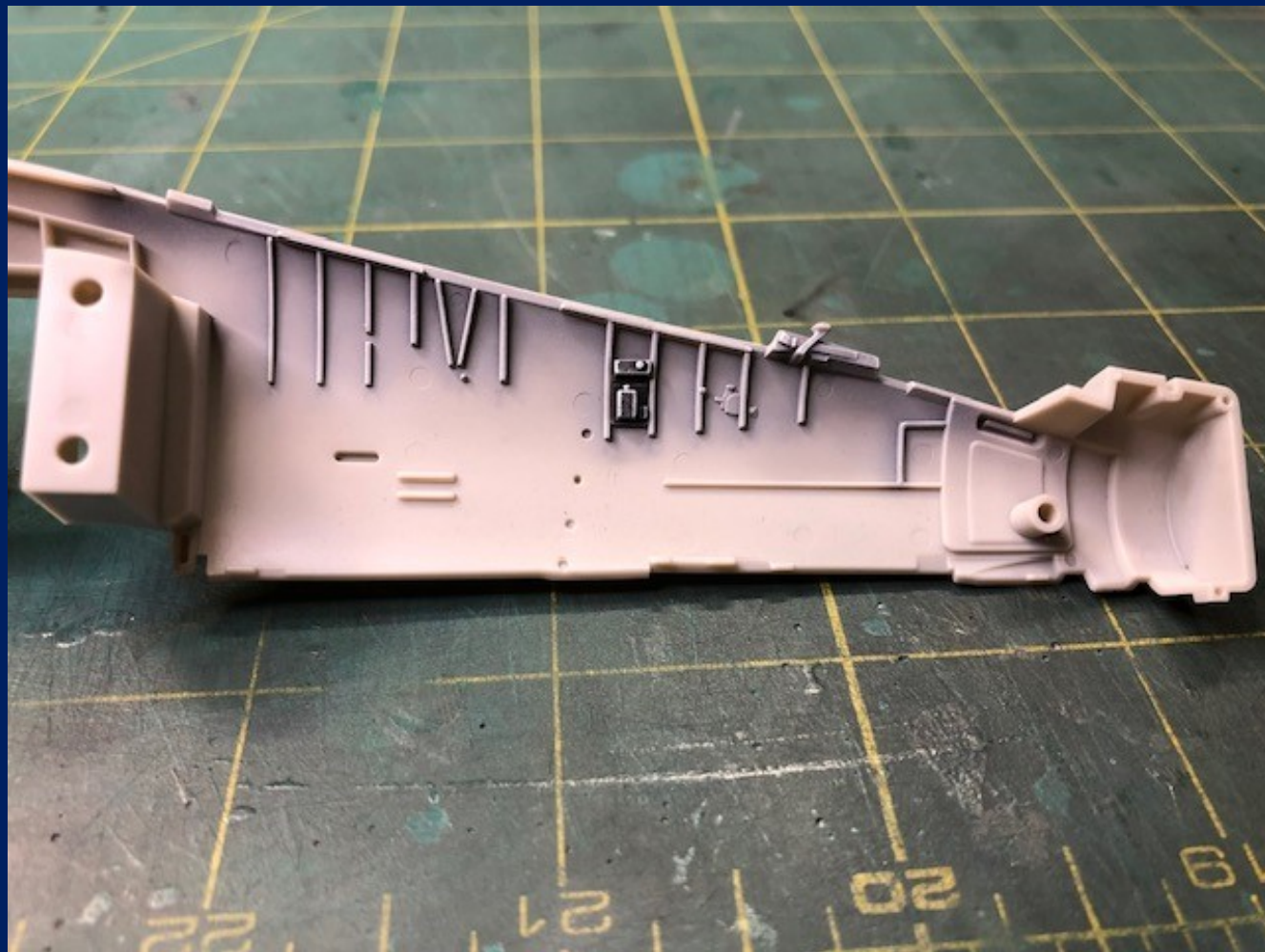


Step 4 (F-4B): Drybrush White

- Same principle as using Neutral Gray
- Use Tamiya XF-2 Flat White

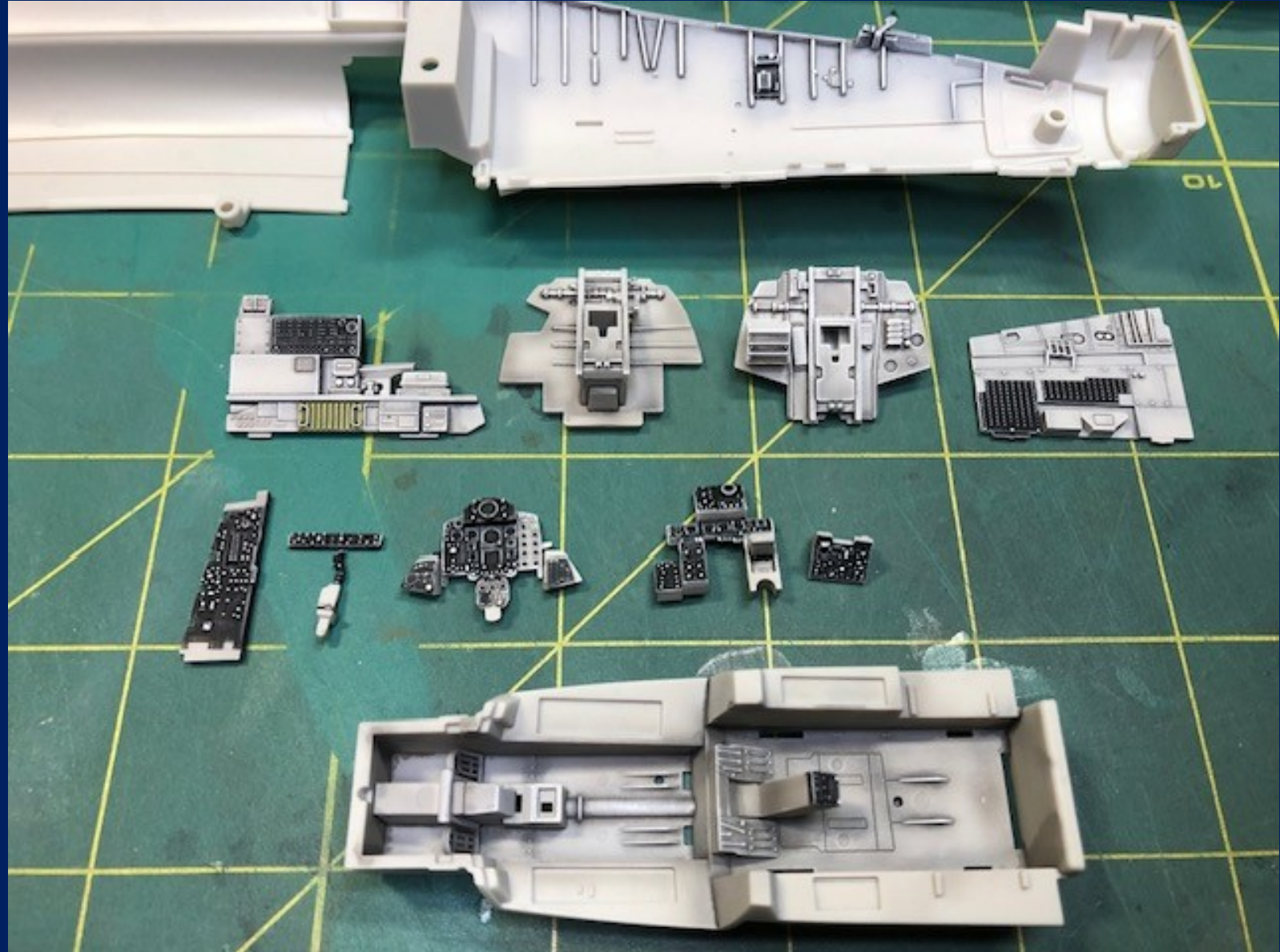


Step 5 (F-4B): Pick out the Details and Apply a Wash

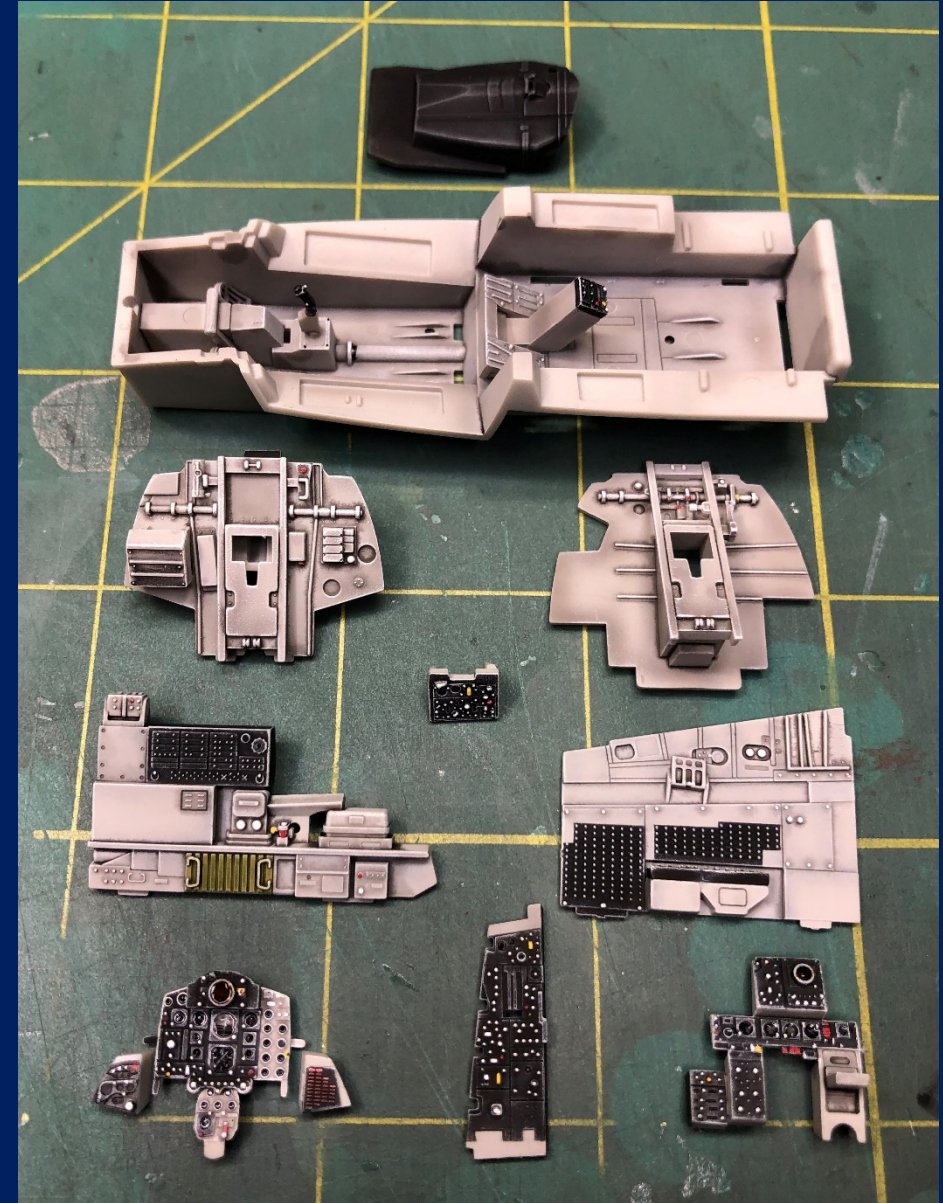
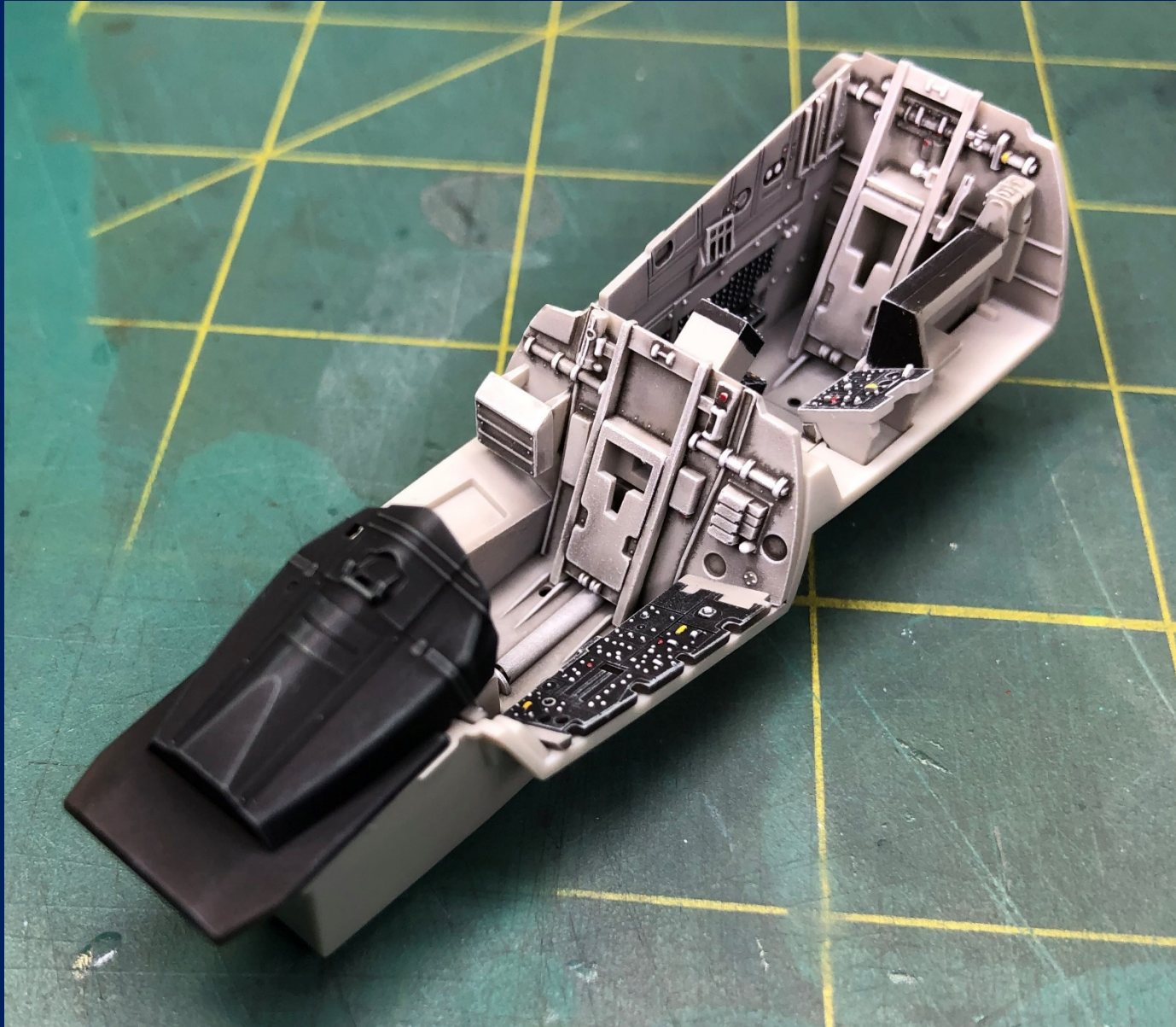


Step 6: Remove the Wash and Blend

- Use a Q-Tip to remove the wash
- Blend the wash so there are no stark areas

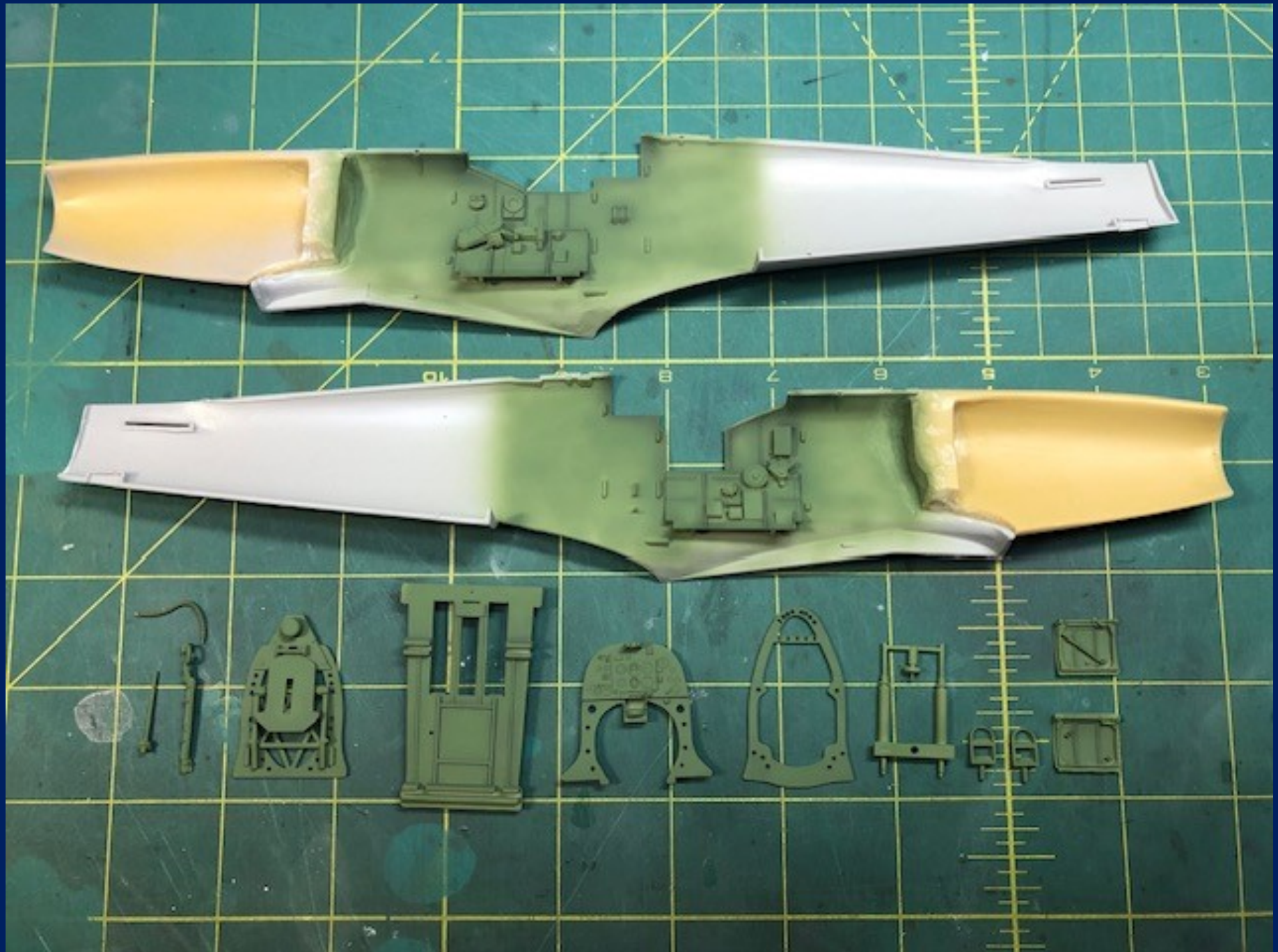


Step 7 (F-4B): Final Detail Painting



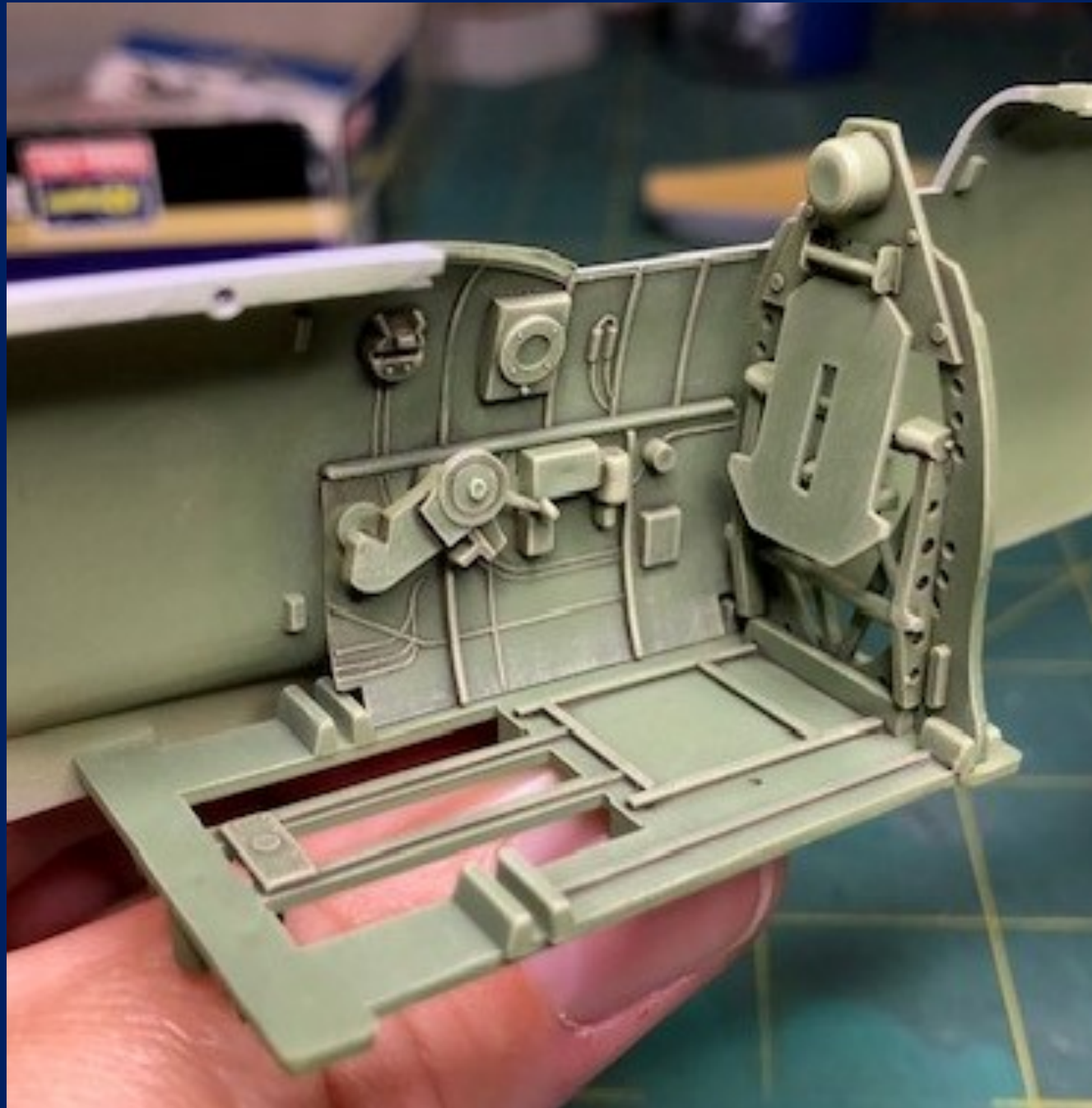
Hasegawa/Paragon 1/32 Mk. XIV

- Same process as the F-4:
 - Base Coat
 - Dry Brush
 - Detail Painting and Wash
 - Blend the Wash
 - Final Detail Painting

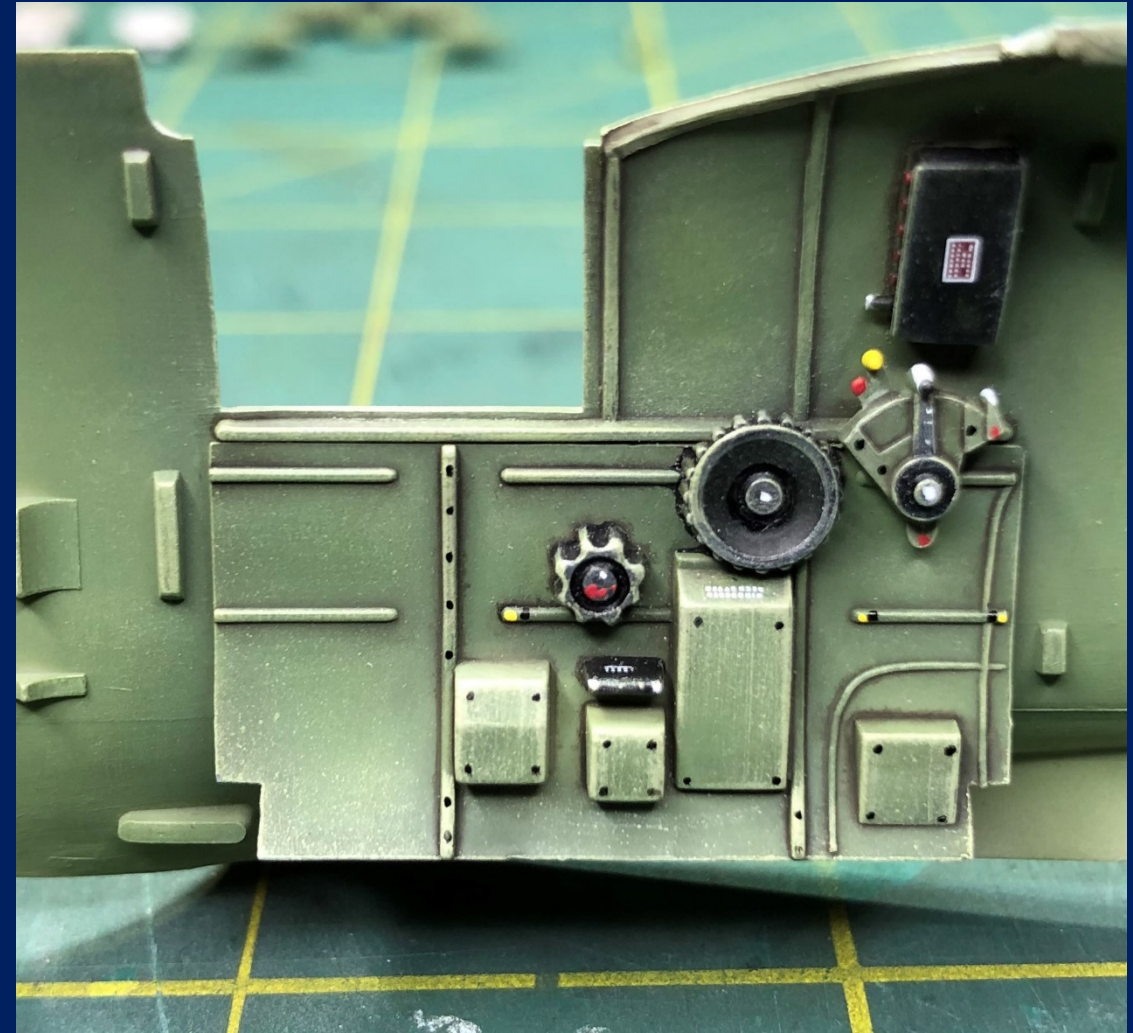
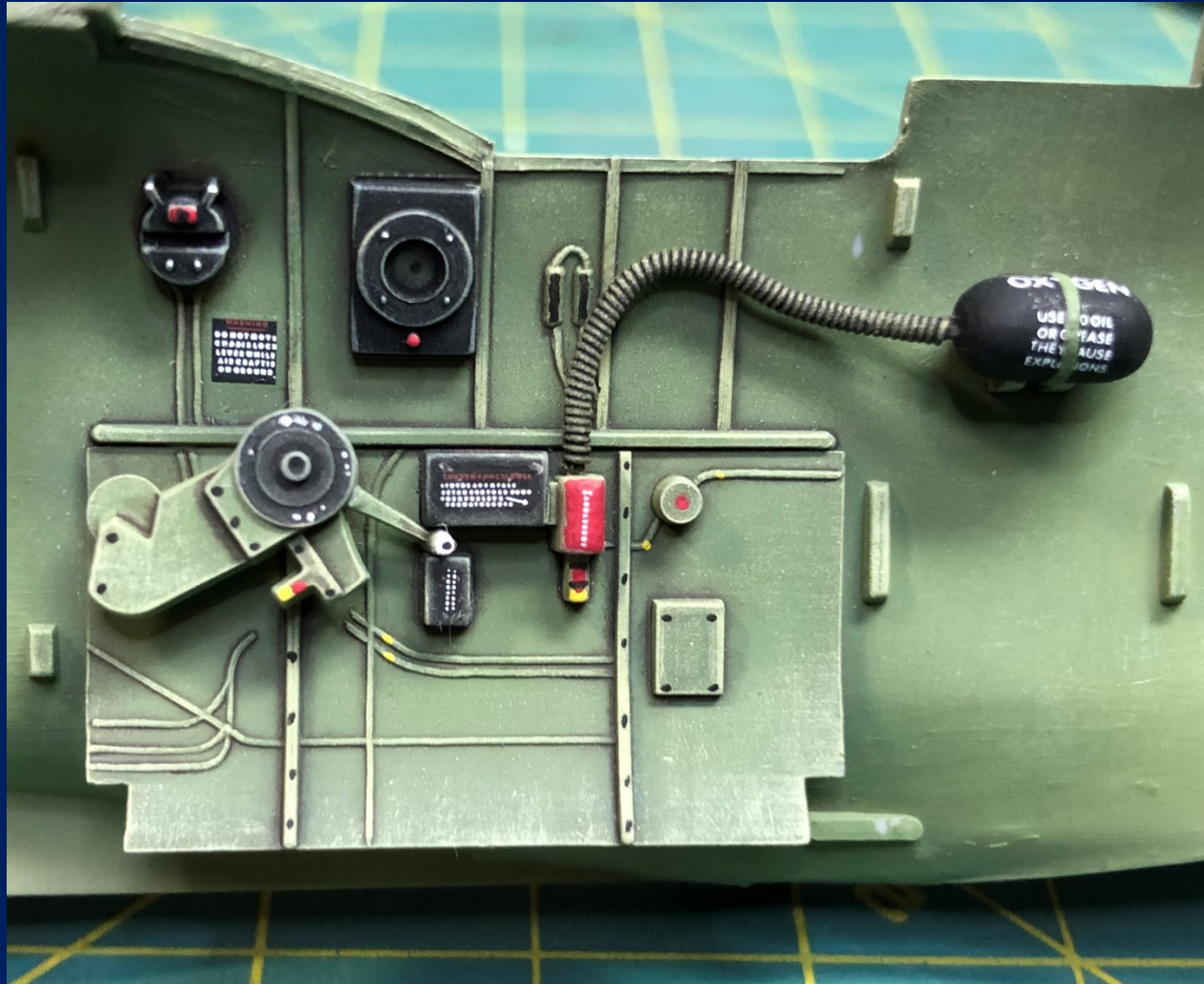


Hasegawa/Paragon 1/32 Mk. XIV: Dry Brush

- Base Color mixed with light gray or light tan
- Try to avoid lightening with white



Hasegawa/Paragon 1/32 Mk. XIV: Detail Painting, Wash, and Final Detail Painting



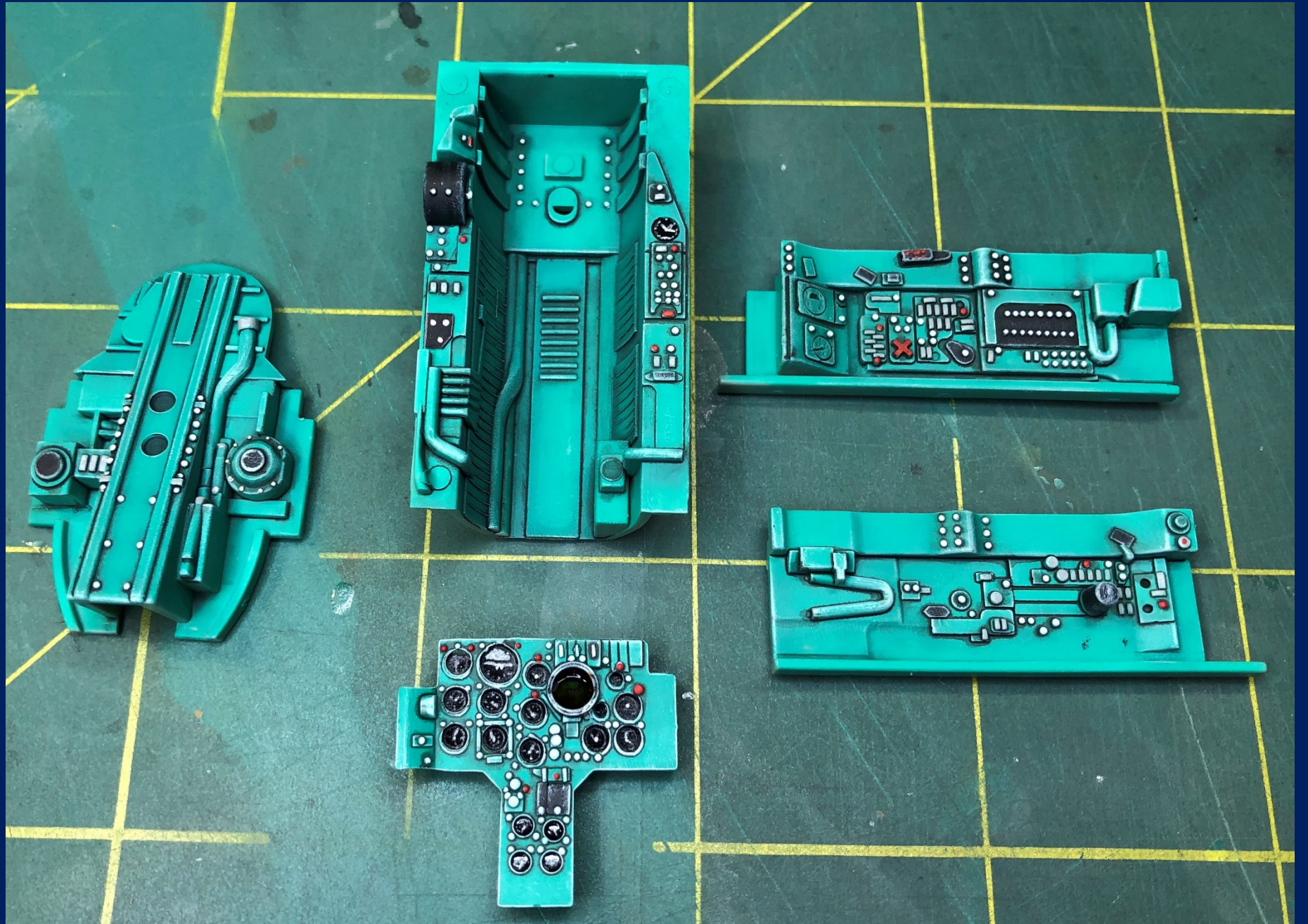

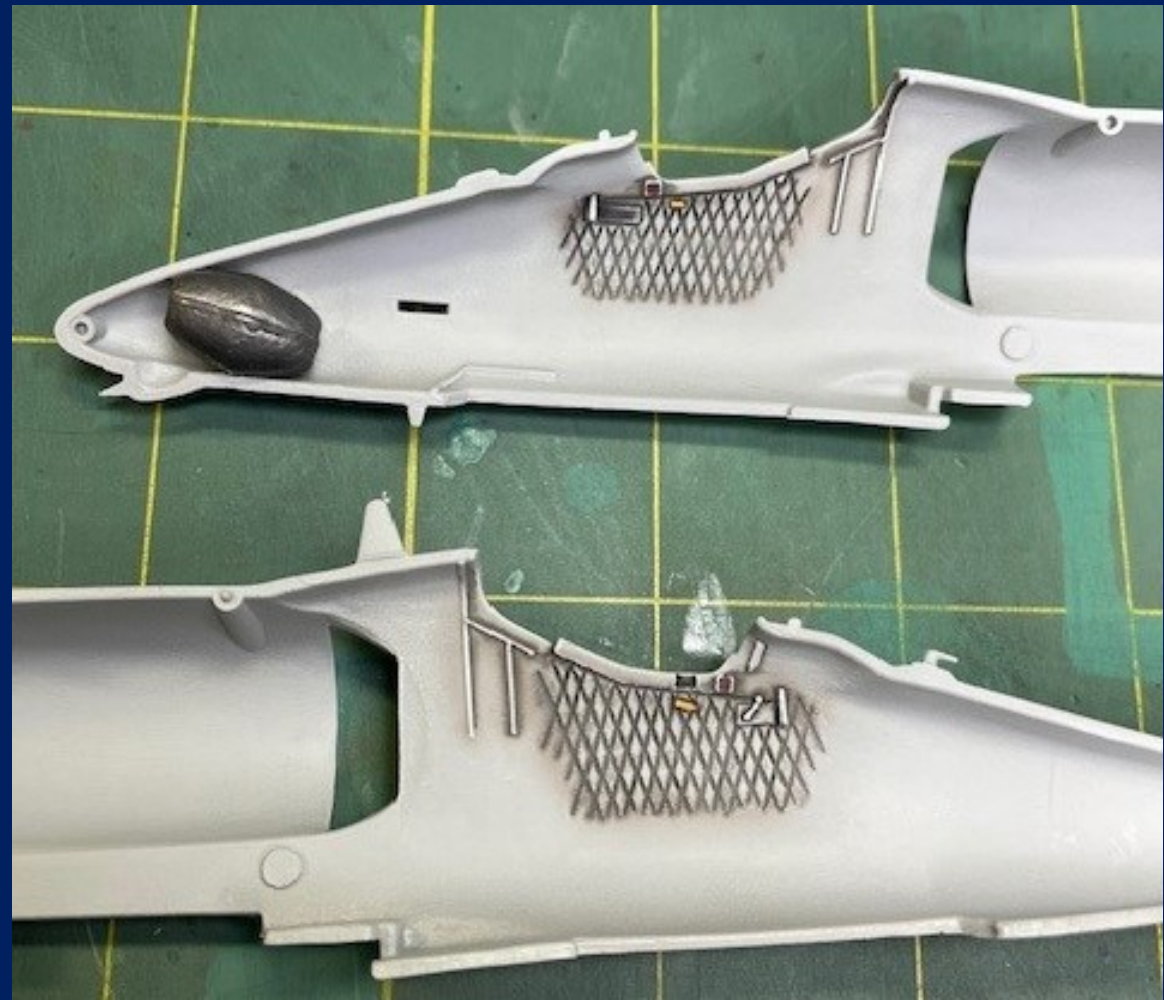

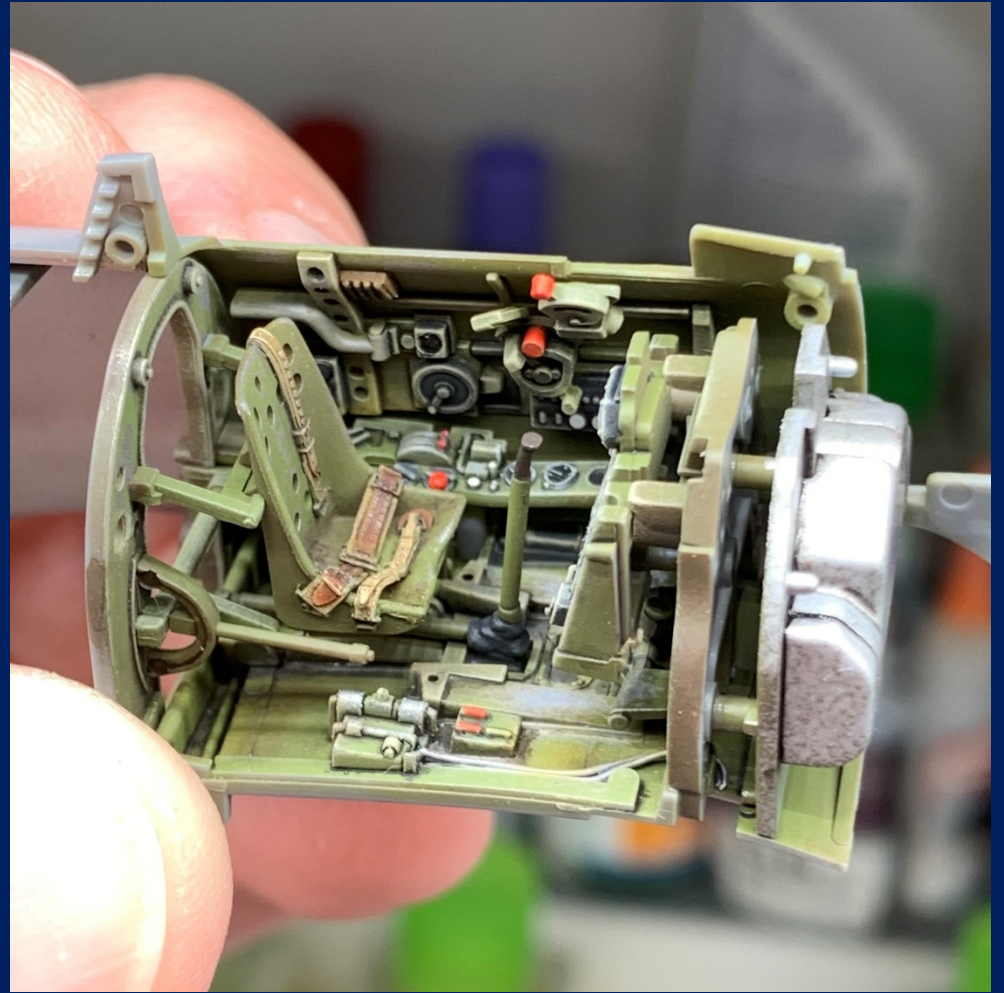

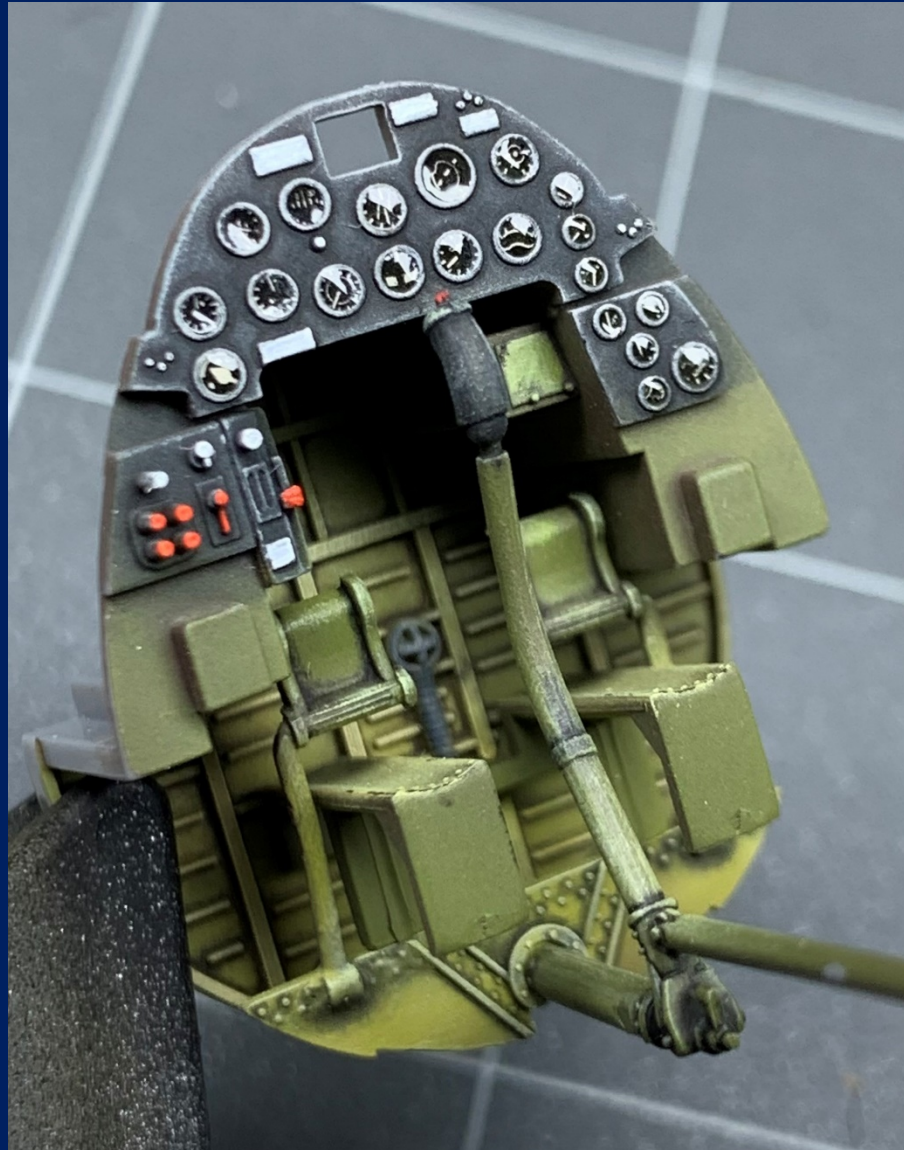
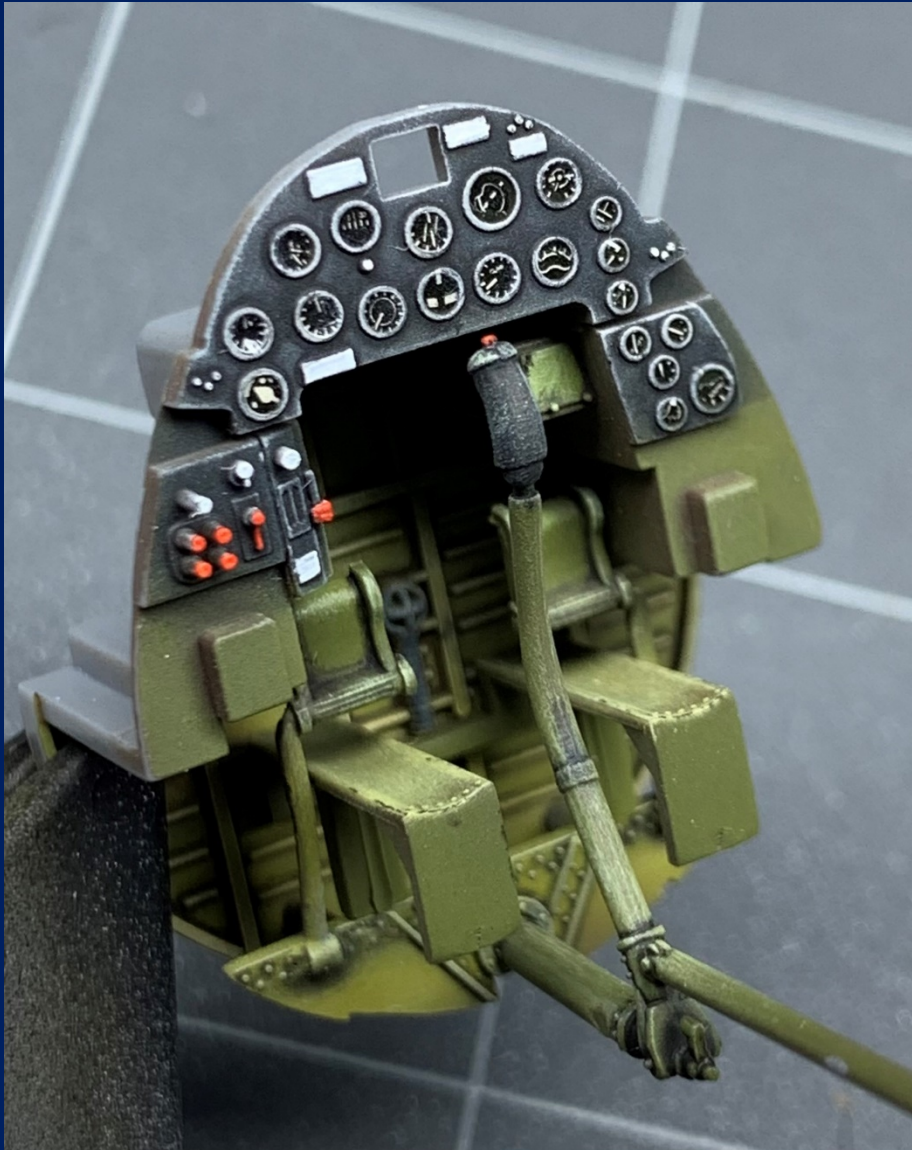

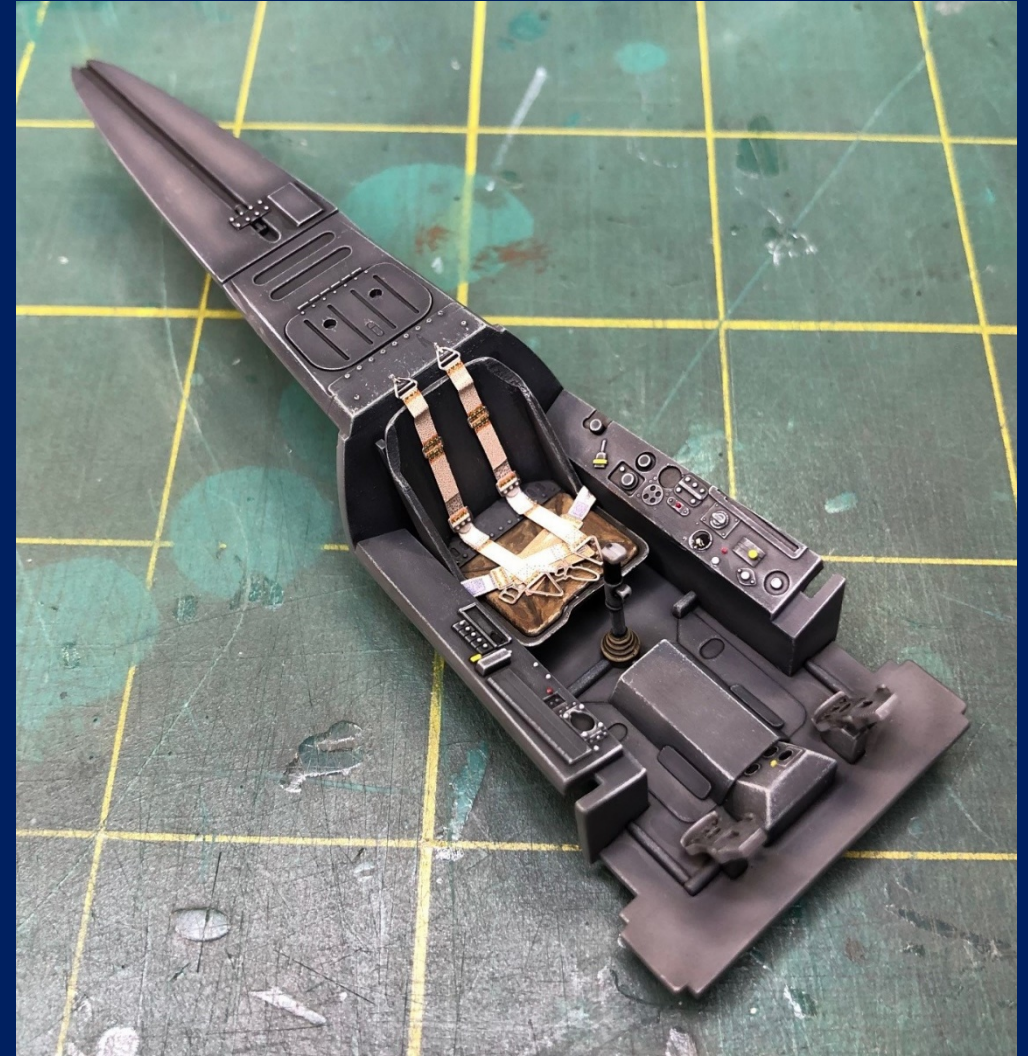
