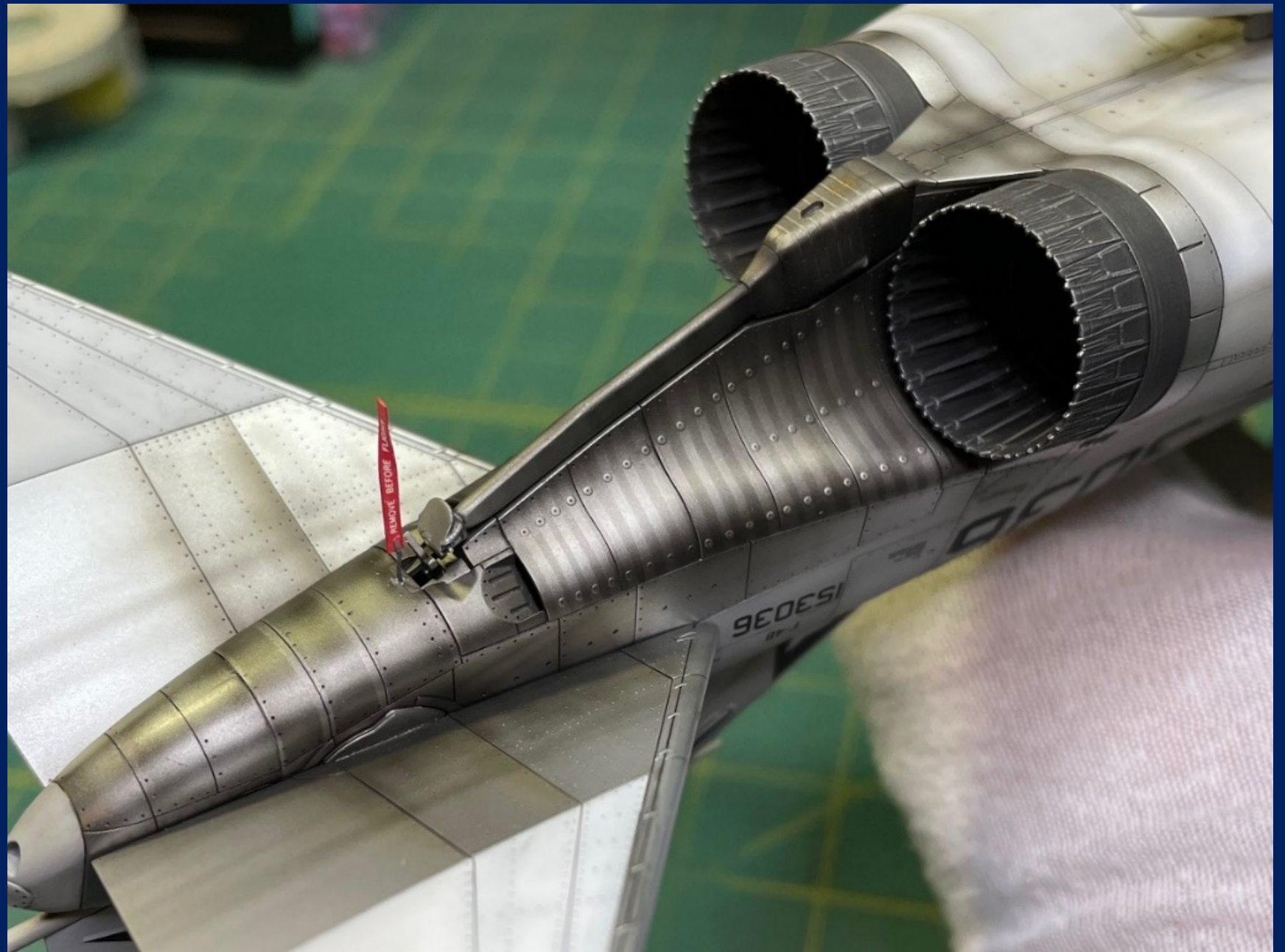

Base Colors (Lacquer):

- MRP Silver 003
- MRP Dura Aluminum 008
- MRP Burnt Metal Violet 156
- MRP Burnt Metal Blue 155
- MRP Black Primer 085
 - ****Only if needed****



Step 1: Masking and Surface Prep

- Need a smooth, polished surface
- Use Tamiya tape
- Use a sharp Xacto knife to cut the tape
- Take your time
- Crisp and clean lines is the goal



Step 2: Base Layer

- MRP Silver 003
- Straight from the bottle
- 12-15 PSI
- Sprayed directly onto the plastic



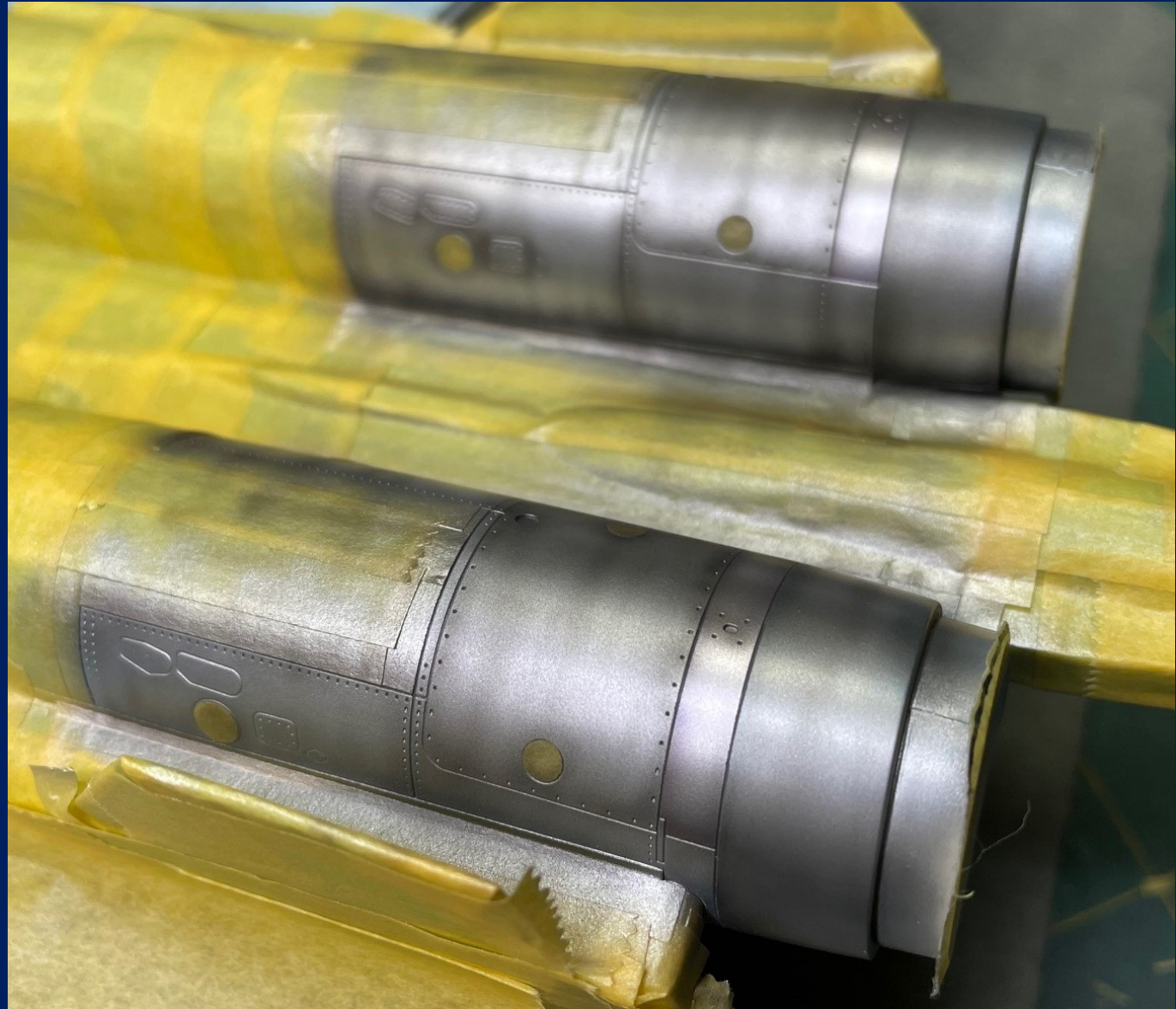
Step 3: Tape Off Areas

- Tape off areas you want to remain silver
- Lightly spray a slightly darker silver
- MRP Dura Aluminum 008
- Quick back and forth motion, gradually building up the paint



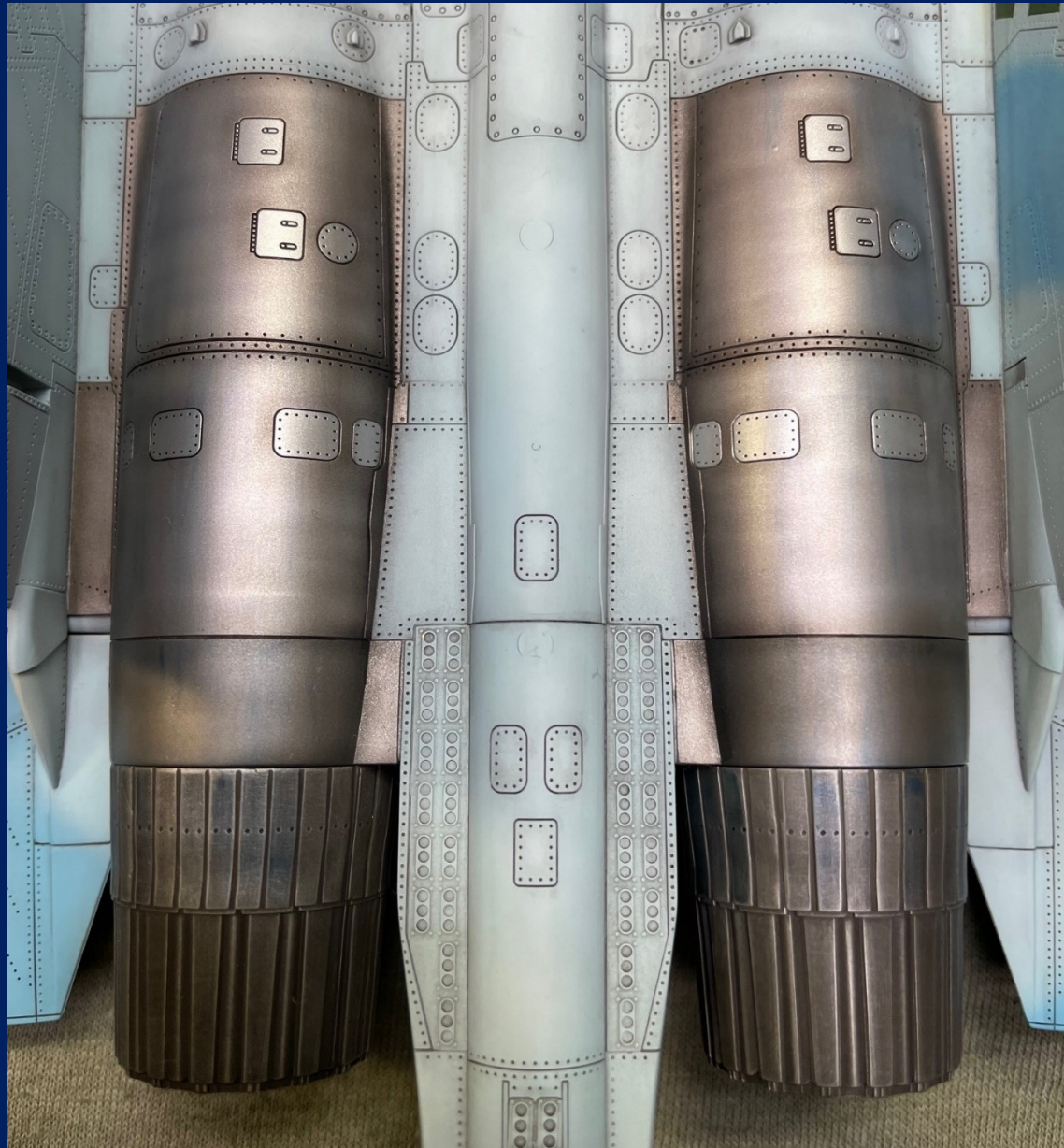
Step 4: Weathering Mix and Polish

- Spray a very thin mix of Tamiya acrylic flat black/ brown mix
- 12-15 PSI
- Top and bottom of engine areas
- More grime underneath
- Polish with a soft cloth



Step 5: Apply a Wash, Then More Polishing...

- Enamel wash
 - Tamiya Panel Line Accent Color (Black)
- Remove excess wash
- Polish with a soft cloth



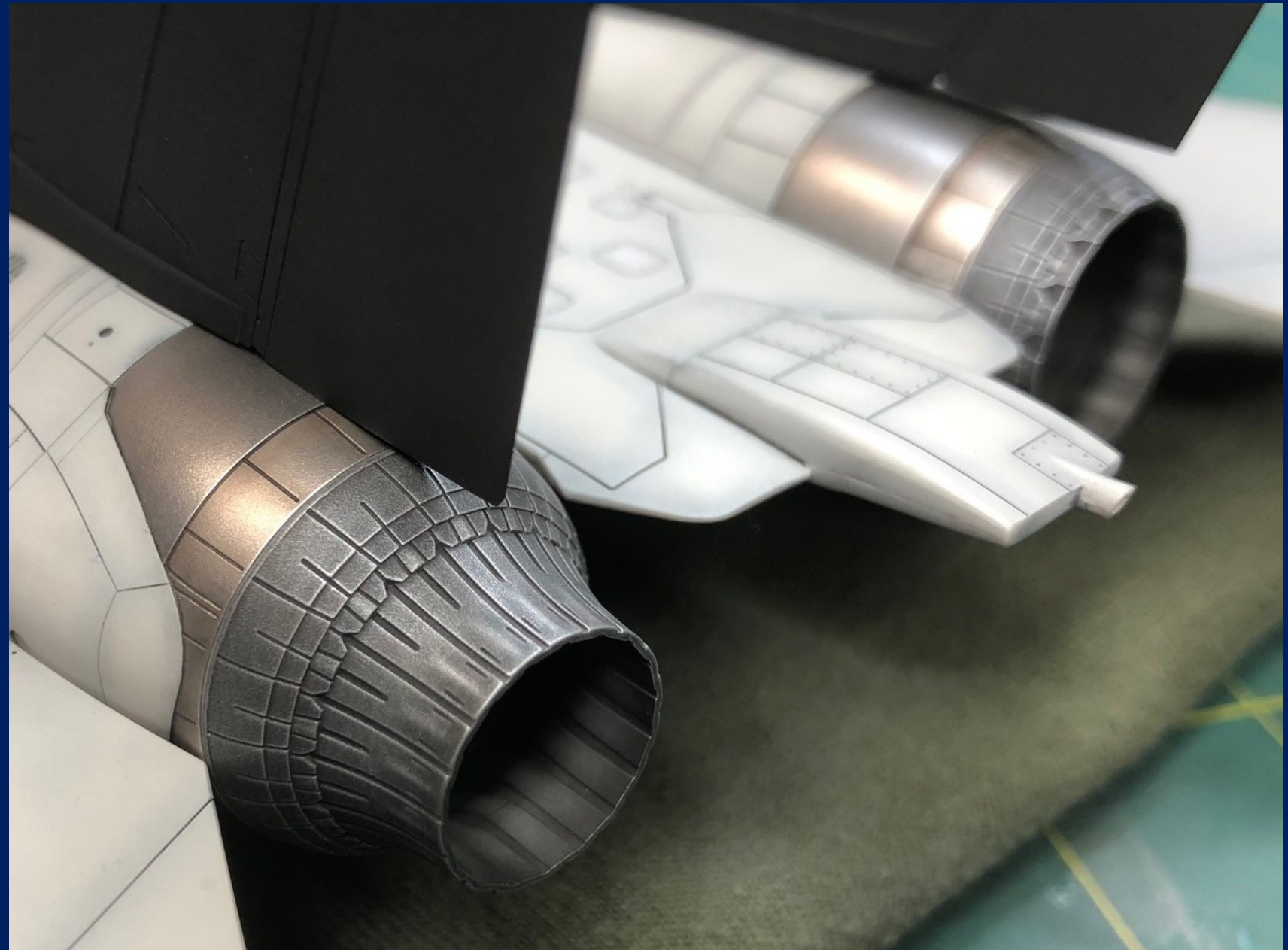
Step 6: Blue/Violet Details, Drybrush, and Final Polish

- Very sparingly, apply Blue and Violet colors
- Drybrush the Nozzles
 - Spray Tamiya Flat Black followed by a MM Chrome Silver Drybrush
- Final Polish with a soft cloth
- No need to clear coat



Tamiya 1/48 F-14A: (Metallic Drybrush)

- Nozzles are Tamiya Flat Black and MM Chrome Silver Drybrush
- Engine area is Tamiya LP-11

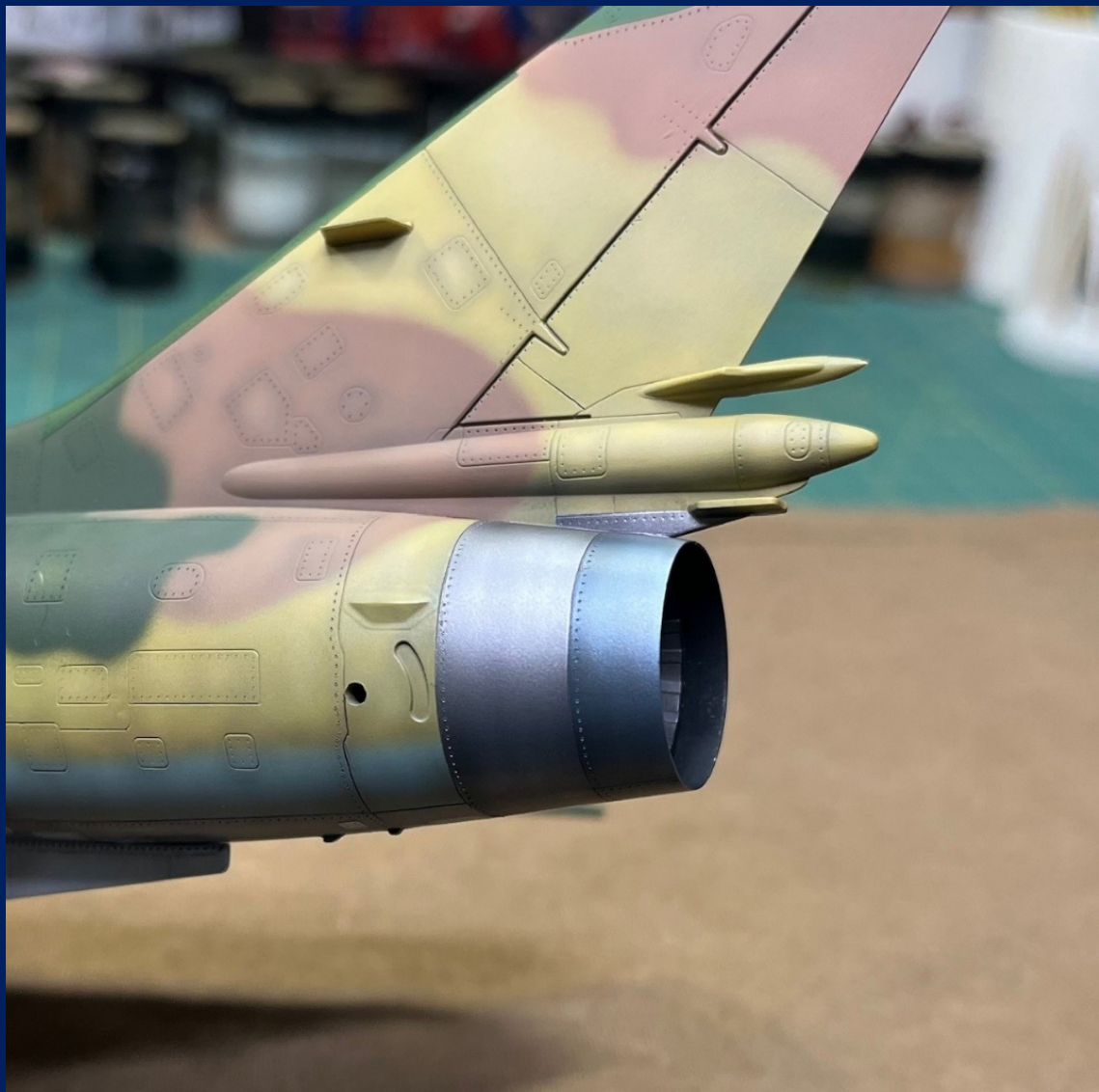


Hobby Boss 1/48 Su-17

- Same process as the 1/48 Su-27
 - Prep Surface (Polish Smooth)
 - Paint base color (MRP Silver 003)
 - Tape
 - Spray Dura Aluminum (MRP 008)
 - Spray weathering mix
 - Wash
 - Blue/Violet
 - Final Polish

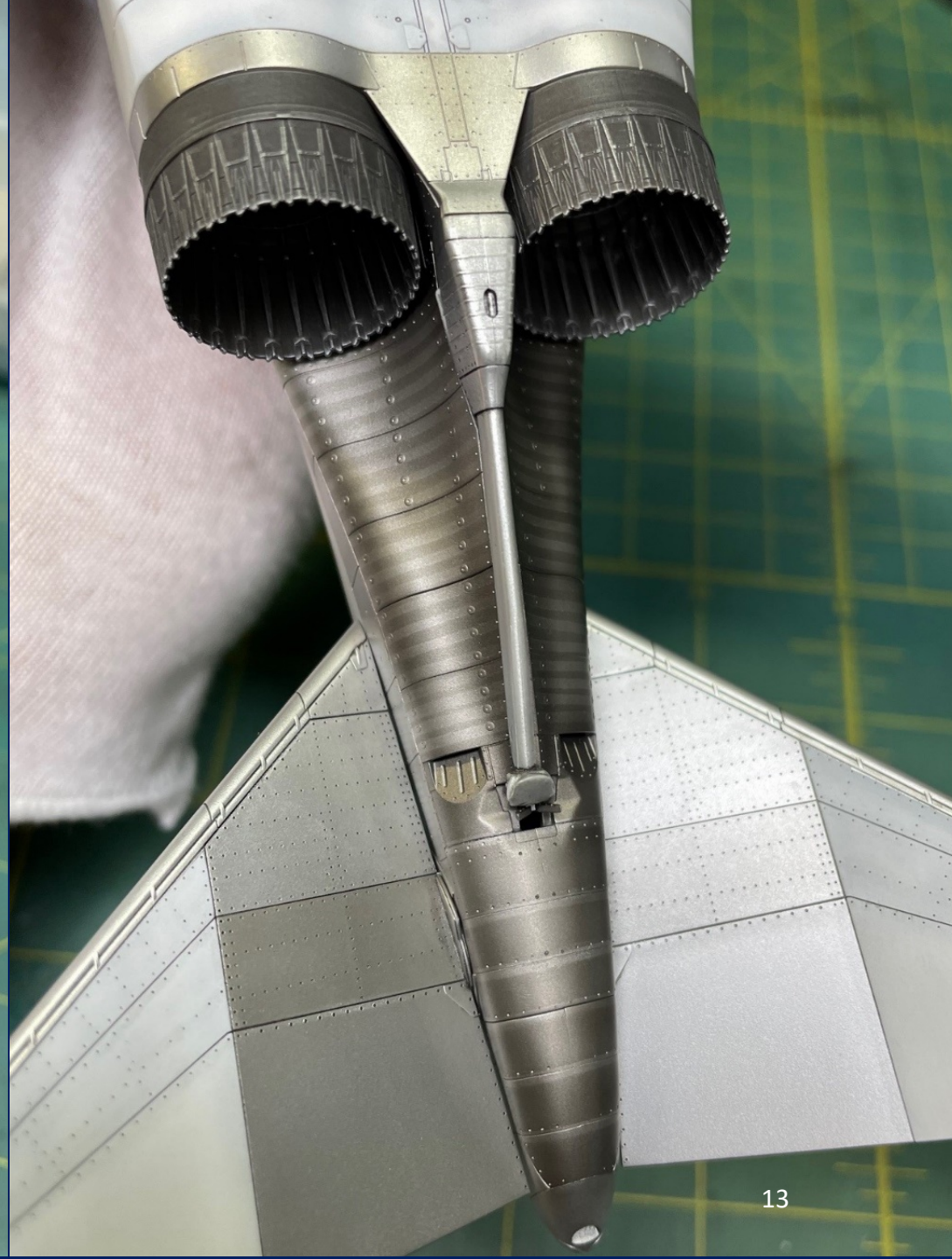


Hobby Boss 1/48 Su-17

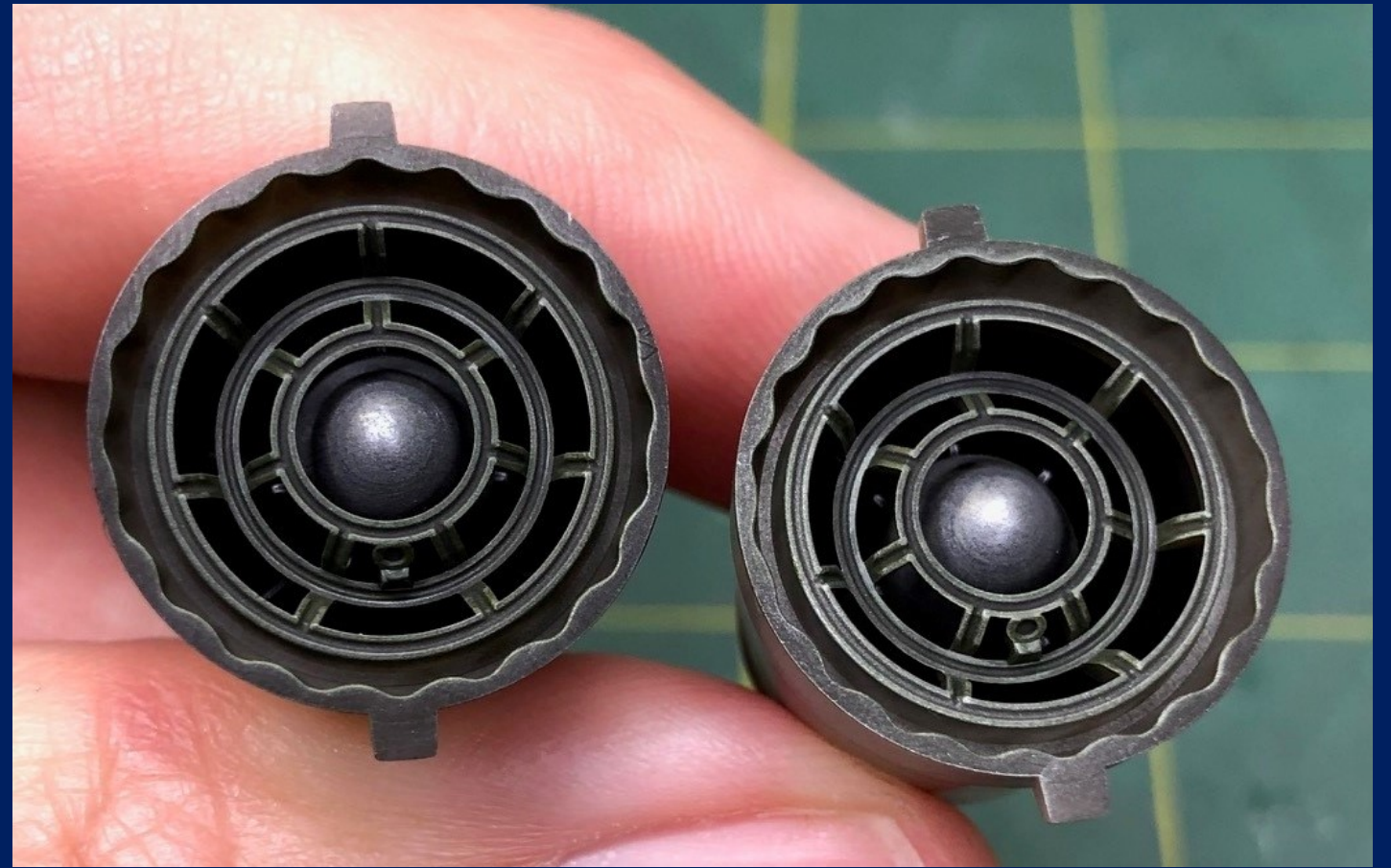

with a touch of green**

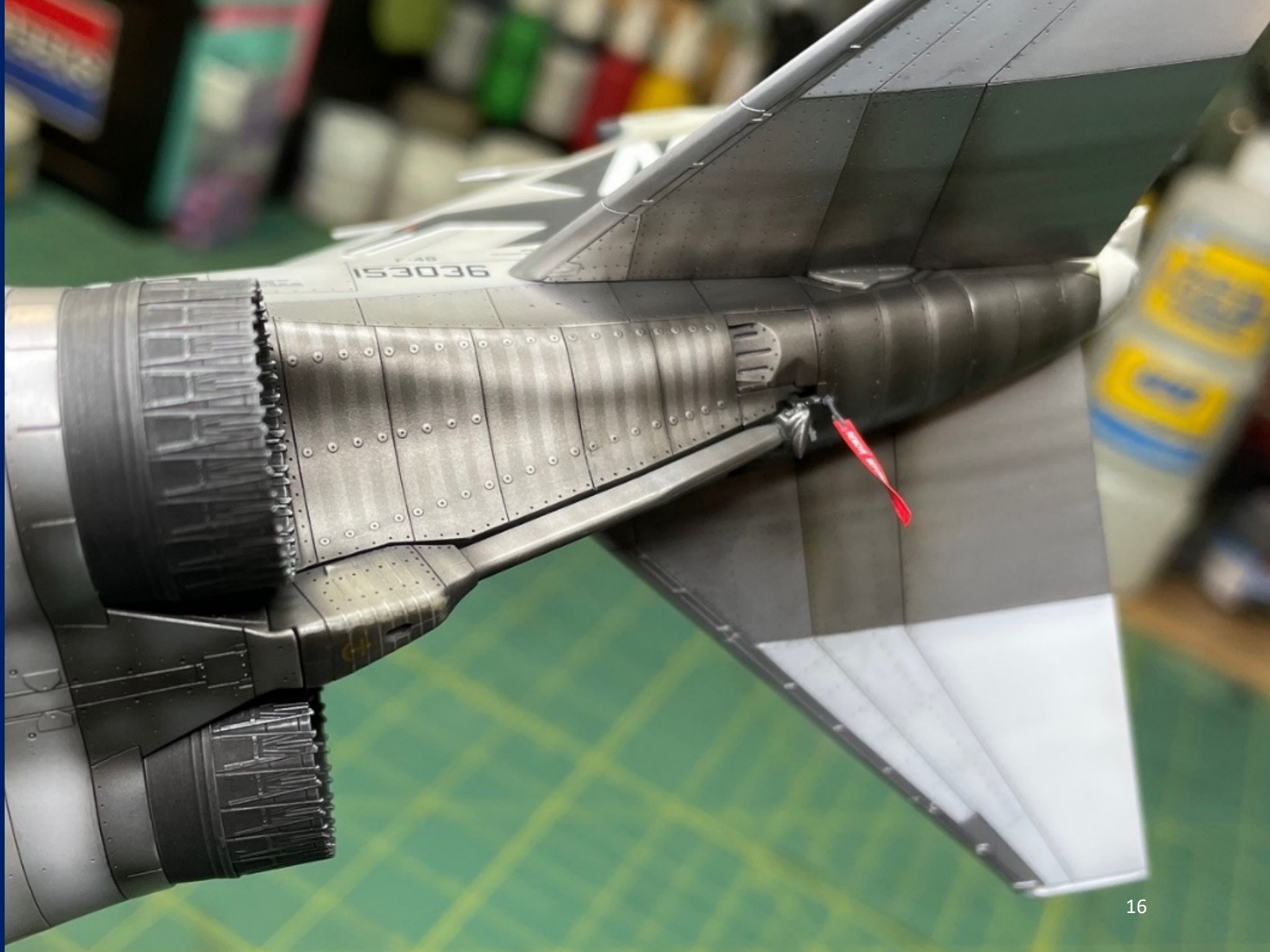
Tamiya 1/48 F-4B Engine and Exhaust OOB

- Add some streaking
- Post-It Notes for a mask



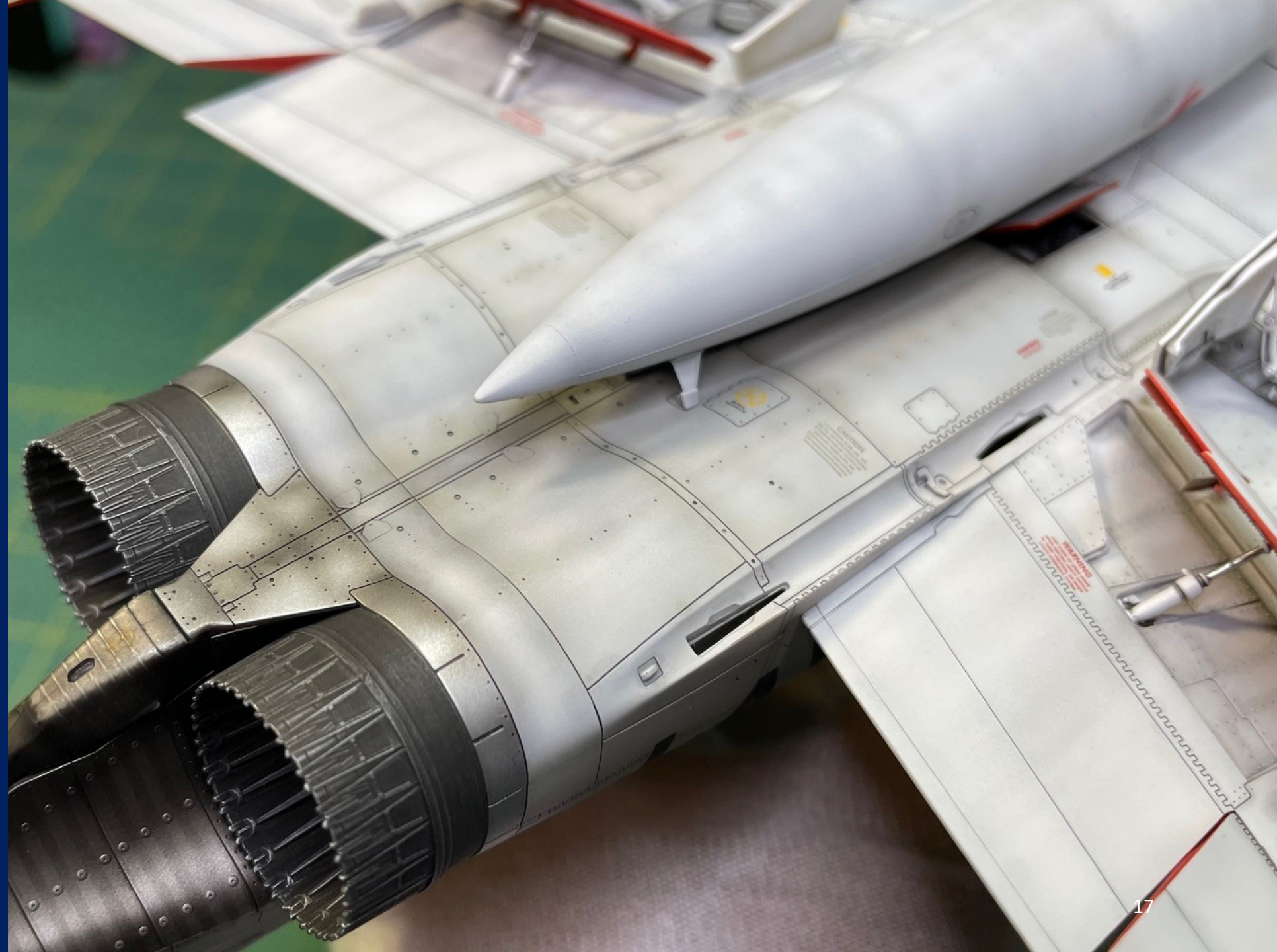
Tamiya 1/48 F-4B Engine and Exhaust OOB

- More exhaust staining with a thin mix of Tamiya Flat Black
 - **Maybe a touch of dark brown



Tamiya 1/48 F-4B Engine and Exhaust OOB

- Don't forget the surrounding area underneath...
- Thin mix of Tamiya Flat Black/Brown Mix
